# Personal, Social & Emotional

### Well Being/Routines

# Early Mathematics

### Number

- Recognise 1-1 correspondence in role play areas.
- Setting table for snack/dinner

### <u>Shape</u>

- Observe and talk about shapes throughout the indoor environment such as tables, windows, doors shelves and containers.
- Will talk about the shape of plates, friut/sandwiches during snack and dinner routines.

# <u>Space</u>

• Independently find spaces for a particular activity such as dancing/floor puzzles/painting.

# Size and Quanity

• will recognise and discuss large/small equipment in all areas

### <u>Pattern</u>

- Make recognise, make , explore and discuss patterns using a wide variety of natural materials
- Observe and talk about patterns in the environment, such as puddles, spiderwebs and leaves.

# Sequence and Time

- will know coat must go on before going out
- Will listen to simple stories
- Talk about season alevents and begin to order "Halloween"/"Autumn"

 Will match items that go together, brushes and dustpan, coat on hook

# Language Development

### Attention and Listening

- Will listen to each other and share experiences
- Will take part in listening games
- Will respond to lights out with a signal rule 1, 2, 3 stop

### Conversational skills/Talking

- Take turns in conversation
- Make an appropriate response or answer a question
- Will begin to use new vocabulary in play expeirence

### Early reading

- Will discuss stories
- Will use show me 5 strategy to get ready to listen and look

### Early writing skills

- Will observe adults writing
- Will scribble and experiment in the free writing area

### Ryhthm and Rhyme

• Will be aware of phonological sounds

### The Arts

### Mark Making

- Will make marks on easel, the floor or table top. Making marks and impressions with fingers and different tools in wet sand and mud
- Will explore different consistencies of paint through adding water.

#### Paint

 Will develop manipulative control in use of paints through holding and loading a brush with paint

# Malleable Materials

- Use various tools such as hands or sticks to model, shape and cut
- Will texture and smooth surfaces

# Spatial awareness through use of 3d

- Experimenting with different ways to stick or join materials e.g. using addhesives, paste, pva, making tape, selloptape etc.
- Creating opportunies to use scissors and punches.

#### **Drama**

 Be involved in group role play -dressing up cloths and props will be available to enhance their play

- Will clap, march and perform actions to the beat of the music.
- Move to the speed of music

#### Gross Motor skills

- Will take part in bi lateral motor coordinatuon activities.
- Will uses upperarm strengh- will push long handled brushes,
- Will pull their own body upwards.

#### Fine Motor skills

• Children will poke, point and reach.

### Developmental Movement/cross lateral

- will crawl, step
- will jump and land, rock and slide-vestibular skills
- will start and stop when requested.-proprioceptive skills

- Will move freely around both inside and outside.
- Will learn use all equipment safely and appropriately
